15+ million clients are served electronically and remotely every year

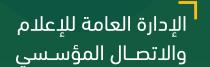
20+ million drives to justice facilities every year have been cancelled

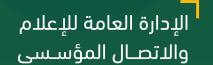

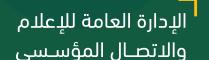
